This workshop starts with Introduction to electronic Medical records and their importance, which was taken by Dr. Atul Shrivastava. Their after he gave information about history of Family of classification and how this 10 revision of International classification of Disease came into existence. His lecture covered a brief details about first to eleven revision of ICD and various other supplementary editions. In this workshop Mr. Shrimant kumar also informed all the participants about various activities conducted by central bureau of health intelligence.

The next lecture was on overview of chapters of ICD-10 which was taken by Dr. Dhruvendra Pandey. He covered all the details of chapter, blocks, categories and sub categories noted on three different volume of ICD-10. He also taught about how easily these can be implement in their department with some workout.

International classification of disease includes various codes for different diseases. This covered very well by Dr. Atul Shrivastava in their next lecture on Basic coding guidelines and coding structures. Coding of disease needs various special characters and abbreviations. So without excersice this learning process was incomplete. Dr. Atul shrivastava and Dr. Shushma Shrivastava gave some excersice to all the participants and they have to code them with help of all the volume of ICD 10 book. This workshop

enriched with discussion at various points and also this showed participants interest and enthusiasm. Medical certification of cause of death is a important legal document and most of time it found to wrongly filled. Dr. Atul taught about correct way of filling this document and also covered various point where the medical practitioner committed mistake. At the end of this academic session various participants gave their feedback. Participants told that a it's a very good learning process and also because this college is in inception stage so implementation of ICD -10 is easy. The trainer for this workshop was very energetic and knowledgable. Some participants gave feedback that this kind of academic and learning activity should be happen at regular interval.
