Working in close collaboration with the Police Department, District Administration, and social welfare agencies, the department provides comprehensive psychiatric evaluation, treatment, and follow-up care while actively tracing patients' families and facilitating their safe reintegration into society. The project also collaborates with Apna Ashram which rescues and shelters vulnerable individuals by providing food, accommodation, and daily care. Through coordinated medical, social, and rehabilitative efforts, Project MILAAP restores dignity, promotes recovery, and reunites individuals with their families, helping them rebuild meaningful and productive lives
